1. Welcome Opening: Elaina Padilla

- Description of the function of Sports Boosters– Elaina explained that Sports Boosters is each team’s accountant. Each board member briefly described to the attending coaches what their specific job duty is and how the coaches’ benefit from our positions. Elaina passed out a short questionnaire to the coaches asking about the desire for/ viability of the Blue and Gold Event and usefulness of Sports Boosters Board.
- Sally Brandon gave a report on Sports Boosters income and expenses.
 - \$ 17,000 is spent in matching funds to the teams for the sale of the Blue and Gold Cards.
 - \$37,000 income from the sale of Gold Cards.

- \$60,000 income for the Blue & Gold Event
 - \$51,000 pay out to the individual 23 teams for their participation in the Blue & Gold Event
 - \$9,000 for EDH Physical Therapy
 - \$11,000 for Board positions
 - \$9,000 for Board debts
 - \$2,000 for scholarships to a boy and a girl
 - \$4,200 for miscellaneous expenses such as checks, storage fees, bank fees,, general expenses.
 - Sports Marketing Club is now self funded and Sports Boosters no longer pays for this program.
- There was a discussion regarding the commitment level of the coaches' regarding the Blue & Gold Event. Specifically, the problem of attendance to said event with many teams having their own specific fundraising events. The Sports Booster Board wanted to know if the coaches wanted the event, and if so, what changes if any, should be made. There was agreement that the 2017 event at Mercedes-Benz was successful and the cocktail/ heavy appetizer format was well received. Discussion centered on how to make it better attended due to parent overload. Ideas included getting a "name" guest speaker, game videos of the teams played during the event, and moving the date to Fall instead of waiting to have the event in March or April. The discussion included the thought that Fall would be a better time because Senior parents are still involved and a greater sense of excitement/involvement for all in the beginning of a new school year. The drawback to Fall versus Spring for the date of the event is that most teams have not been formed in the Fall. Additionally, objection was voiced that a Fall Blue & Gold Event would overshadow/step on the heels of the Foundation Golf Tournament held the Monday before Homecoming. However, comments included that the events are actually drawing on different attendees and that we could have a week of celebration with the Blue & Gold Event on the Saturday that precedes Homecoming. Coaches voiced they were committed to a Blue & Gold Event.
 - Patty Doshier passed out a letter to the coaches that asked for chairpersons for the Blue & Gold Event.
